4. New PAGES 2k Network Working Group

A new Ocean2k Working Group was recently created to reinforce the PAGES 2k Network. Ocean2k will attempt to reconstruct and analyze the sea surface conditions and marine climate of the last two millennia. Paleoceanographic evidence will be compiled from high-resolution archives, mostly sedimentary cores and corals. The group's overall objectives, as of all the regional groups, will be data compilations, spatial and temporal synopsis, comparison with models, and of synthesis.
