1a. Tipping Points Discussion Series: *Interactions & Cascades of Climate Tipping Points*

This series of online discussions convened by AIMES, Future Earth, Earth Commission and WCRP aims to advance the knowledge about tipping points, irreversibility, and abrupt changes in the Earth system. This month the talk is focused on '*Interactions & Cascades of Climate Tipping Points*', and will delve into the current state of literature on tipping point interactions and discuss risks for cascading transitions under current global warming trajectories.

These 60-90 min events are held monthly and feature presentations from scientists working on the frontiers of earth systems research. The next event will be held on **19 June at 1430 CEST (1230 UTC)**, and will feature a roundtable discussion with Nico Wunderling (Potsdam Institute for Climate Impact Research, Center for Critical Computational Studies, Frankfurt am Main) and Anna von der Heydt (Institute for Marine and Atmospheric Research, Utrecht University).
